**TITLE** : PERSONALIZE SYSTEM WITH WINDOWS XP (CLO1)

**Learning Outcomes** :

By the end of this lab, students should be able :

1. To personalize his or her operating system based on his or her choices.
2. To setting Visual Effects
3. To setting sound according program event.

To enable clear type font.

**Tools** : Windows XP Operating System (Professional Edition)

**Procedures** :

**A. How to disable or enable specific Visual Effects**

- i. Click **Start**, right-click **My Computer**, and click **Properties**.
- ii. The **System Properties** dialog box appears. Click the **Advanced** tab. In the **Performance** area, click **Settings**.
- iii. The **Performance Options** dialog box appears. On the **Visual Effects** tab, select the **Custom** option.
- iv. Clear the check boxes for the visual effects you want to disable. To enable the visual effects click the option that you like in the checkbox.
- v. Click **OK** after finish the selection.
- vi. You are returned to the **System Properties** dialog box. Click **OK**.

**B. To change the sound associated with a program event**

- i. [Log on to your computer as an administrator](#). Click **Start**, and then click **Control Panel**.
- ii. Click **Sounds, Speech, and Audio Devices**.
- iii. Click **Change the sound scheme**. The **Sounds, Speech, and Audio Devices Properties** dialog box appears.
- iv. In the **Program events** list, click an event. Then, click the **Play** button to listen to the sound currently assigned to the event. The sound probably sounds familiar. If you decide to change it, you'll hear your new sound in place of the current sound.
- v. To change the sound, click the **Sounds** list down arrow, and select a different system sound. To choose a sound that you have downloaded or recorded, click the **Browse** button, select the sound, and then click **OK**. Click the **Play** button again to preview the sound.
- vi. Repeat steps 4 and 5 to change more sounds assigned to program events. When you are satisfied with your sounds, click **Save As**.
- vii. In the **Save Scheme As** dialog box, type a name for your scheme, and then click **OK**.

**C. To enable ClearType**

- i. In the **Display Properties** dialog box, click the **Appearance** tab
- ii. Click the **Effects** button.
- iii. Click the **Use the following method to smooth edges of screen fonts** check box (if it is not already selected), click the down arrow, and then click **Clear Type**.
- iv. Click **OK**.
- v. In the **Display Properties** dialog box, click **OK** again.
